THE HONORABLE ANTONIN SCALIA

In 1986 President Ronald Reagan selected Judge Antonin Scalia of the US Court of Appeals, District of Columbia Circuit, to take the seat on the US Supreme Court vacated by the appointment of William Rehnquist as Chief Justice. Judge Scalia's appointment won unanimous approval in the Senate, and he became the youngest person ever selected for the court. In the 21 years since his swearing-in, Justice Scalia has become one of the best known and most respected jurists in our nation's history. His opinions are marked by his deep respect for the Constitution and "stare decisis," the belief that great weight should be given to settled precedents and judicial restraint. His work has become the subject of several books for both the general public and the legal community. A dynamic force on the bench, Justice Scalia is an eloquent and challenging speaker who is willing to engage the public on the topics he believes are critically important.
